



Dear Chartered Mediators in Kenya and Uganda.

The Chartered Mediator designation recognizes a superior level of generalist competence, the goal being to assist those requiring mediation services in finding highly experienced and skilled mediators. The Chartered Mediator designation is awarded to mediators who meet the qualifications set out in our standards, I.E A professional mediator who has undergone a 50 hour professional mediation training (CPM-MTI) and has further undertaken a 50 hour Advanced Mediation Training (CAM-MTI), is a member of the Chartered Institute of Mediators and Conciliators and having conducted individually above 40 cases over a period of over 200 hours and more.

To ensure that a high and consistent set of standards is continuously met by those entitled to use this designation, MTI International East Africa in collaboration with the Institute of Chartered mediators and Conciliators (ICMC) have now introduced a requirement that all Chartered Mediators must attend at least three refresher courses and or two Chartered mediators round table conferences every year. A calendar of events for chartered mediators will be posted on the website shortly. Four Chartered mediators round table conferences and four refresher courses will be organized in Nairobi and Kampala and a chartered mediator can elect to attend any of the two.

A roster for Chartered Mediators will be published shortly to be circulated to the prospective customers. It will be placed in the MTI .E.A and ICMC websites.

We plan for a visit to Singapore international mediation institute (SIMI) this year, those willing to travel will be asked to forward their names to the secretariat as soon as the logistics are put in place.

We are organizing for a breakfast meeting with the Chief Justice and the Chartered mediators only in Nairobi. Our secretariat will communicate accordingly.
