



MEDIATION ROLE PLAYS WORKSHOP- MENTORSHIP OPPORTUNITY

DATE: 12th February 2021

VENUE: CONVENT INTERNATIONAL HOTEL LAVINGTON NAIROBI

Because of the Covid 19 pandemic and accompanying restrictions, most people have not had a chance to practice the skills they learnt during their professional mediation training. Most have not had the **chance for mentorship**. We understand the frustrations that have ensued because of circumstances that were beyond our control.

Cognizant of that, we have organized a number of Role-plays workshops and invited **highly experienced mediators**, to **coach, guide and mentor** those who have not had an opportunity to practice.

The role-plays workshop will take the **whole day from 8.30 am to 5 pm on 12th February 2021 at Convent international Hotel Lavington Nairobi**. We have made **similar arrangements for other towns in Kenya** and one other in **Kampala** in the course of the year. Cost is kshs 6000/= for your conference package and a token to the coaches and mentors

OBJECTIVES OF THIS ROLE PLAYING/MENTORSHIP WORKSHOPS FOR “YOUNG” MEDIATORS

- Role-playing promotes deep learning, long-term retention and can be very memorable and powerful.
- Participants might feel awkward at first, but they are encouraged to participate as fully as possible. The more authentically they engage in their role the more they will learn.
- There are no “right” answers in role-plays.
- Participants will not be graded.
- Because role-plays will be participatory, the information learned will be retained longer and will be more easily accessible in the future when it is needed.

- The scenarios will be based on real situations that real people encounter.
- After the role-play, Participants will discuss the experience and the outcome of the real-life situation upon which the role-play is based.
- For anyone who is truly too uncomfortable to try it out (which I doubt) , we have an observer role. The observers are expected to take notes as they watch others do the role-play and then to provide comments back to the other participants in their group at the end of the process.
- For those who need scripts, We will Create scripts for the participants to use that include words and phrases that are regularly used in professional mediation.
- The Role-plays will be many, each focused on one specific skill.
